

## CODE OF CONDUCT

## STUDENT AND FAMILY RIGHTS:

- The right for each family member to be treated with honest consideration, respect, and dignity.
- The right to participate in a school environment with activities designed to encourage independence, learning, growth and a lifetime of learning.
- The right to develop a strong partnership with the school to ensure the best learning outcomes for the student.
- The right to accurate information about observations about the child.
- The right to a safe, secure environment.
- The right to have children honored, free from harm, and in a healthy environment.
- The right to be part of a supportive community which provides opportunities for meaningful relationships.
- To partner with parents to ensure that their child in a culturally responsive manner that both affirming to the child and other children in their community.

## STUDENT AND FAMILY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The responsibility to treat the Suzuki School faculty and other families in a courteous and respectful manner free of personal attacks, threats, cursing, harmful gossip, or hostile confrontation.
- The responsibility to directly and respectfully communicate with faculty and staff concerns regarding your child on a regular and ongoing basis as part of our partnership together
- The responsibility to be as accurate and forthright when providing information on about the health and
  development of your child, such as changes in home life that may affect a child's behavior at school, health
  issues and history, pre-existing or emerging developmental or behavioral concerns, feedback from outside
  therapists, and any personal care needs of the child.
- The responsibility to partner with the school to address the complex developmental or behavioral needs of my child and to follow through on recommendations in a timely manner.
- The responsibility to supervise your child according to Suzuki standards while in your custody on school premises.
- The responsibility to comply with policies and procedures including abiding by the school's philosophy and approach, and to ask questions if you have them about any of the aforementioned topics.
- The responsibility to notify the Suzuki School of any changes in enrollment status within school guidelines.
- The responsibility to pay tuition on time and in full.
